Visit *Changing Places*, an exhibit at Levine Museum of the New South that explores the realities, myths and misconceptions about the cultures and people that are changing the face of Charlotte and the region. After all, you're one of them.

Let's talk about it! Join us for an exhibit visit, reflection, and facilitated dialogue designed to connect your group in new ways and to increase awareness of what it means to be inclusive as an individual, an organization and a community.

## what is it?

**Speaking of Change** is a 2.5 hour experience that includes an exhibit visit, time for reflection, and a facilitated conversation.

Groups may consist of 12 to 20 individuals from your organization. Dialogues are designed for all types of groups, such as management teams, workgroups, civic, not-for-profits, plus faith-based, grassroots and newcomer groups.

Individuals will silently view selected aspects of the exhibit at their own pace before coming back together as a group for a facilitator-led dialogue about what the exhibit evoked and what it means for individuals and your organization.

Groups will leave with a deeper understanding of Charlotte as a dynamic multicultural New South city and be inspired to further explore that diversity.

## fees and availability

**Exhibit visit and dialogue fee:  
\$150 PER GROUP**

The first 60 not-for-profit and community-based groups pay **ONLY \$25** for an exhibit visit and dialogue session thanks to a grant from Foundation For The Carolinas in support of Crossroads Charlotte. Fee for additional sessions per community group or not-for-profit organization is \$125.
